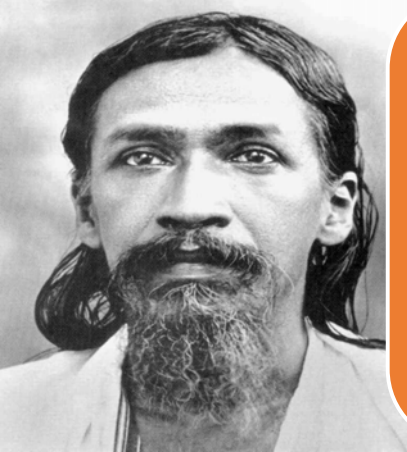


SRI AUROBINDO COLLEGE

SAC is multi-disciplinary college and offers 11 UG courses.

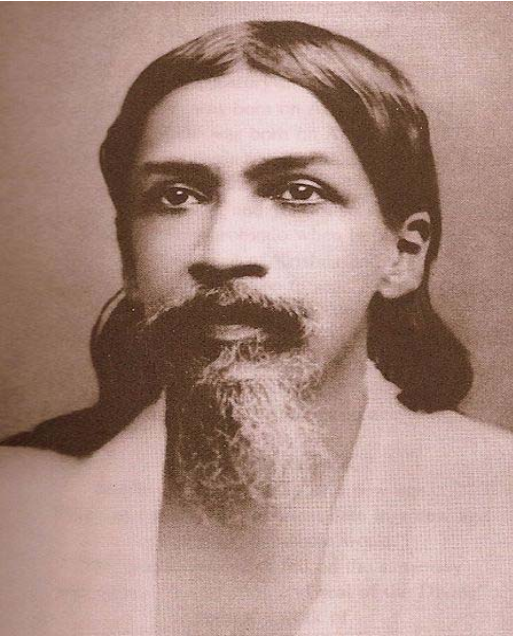

HISTORY



Sri Aurobindo was born in Calcutta on **15 August 1872**. At the age of seven he was taken to England for education and in 1890 went up to King's College, Cambridge. Here he stood in the first class in the Classical Tripos and also passed the final examination for the Indian Civil Service. Returning to India in 1893, he worked for the next thirteen years in the Princely State of Baroda in the service of the Maharaja and as a professor in Baroda College. During this period he also joined a revolutionary society and took a leading role in secret preparations for an uprising against the British Government in India.



Sri Aurobindo College was established by Delhi University in 1972, which was the birth centenary year of the philosopher, patriot-poet, Sri Aurobindo. The college is a constituent part of Delhi University. The college inculcates the ideals of Sri Aurobindo and believes that an active commitment towards excellence is fundamental to the process of education. ➤ Laboratory Facility

The college has well developed laboratories in science department. Physics, Chemistry, zoology, botany and electronics laboratories are very well equipped with latest instruments and apparatus.

➤ Computer Facility

With the introduction of revised and restructured course in various disciplines and use of computer in various science, and arts subjects, the college has set up a computer laboratory with centralised internet facility. The computer lab besides being used by the students to study their course work can also be used to enhance and develop their knowledge in various spheres of education.

➤ Placement Cell

The placement cell was instituted in the college to coordinate between various companies with the college for placement of the students. To name a few, companies like Wipro and Airtel approached the college and few final year students belonging to different courses have been able to find placement even before completing their graduation. The activities of the cell are focused to improve the vision of the students in approaching the job market.
